Master Wildlifer is designed for landowners, land managers and outdoor recreationists who are interested in including wildlife considerations into their current land management activities. Practicing land managers will find the course valuable in highlighting alternative management approaches for wildlife in forest and farm settings. Special emphasis is placed on wildlife species (game species) that currently offer landowners additional sources of income through recreational access fees. Course participants will obtain the knowledge and necessary tools to enhance habitat for a variety of wildlife species that can be enjoyed by themselves, family, friends and anyone interested in wildlife.

## Locations

The course will be conducted in Abbeville, Anderson, Beaufort, Bennettsville, Bishopville, Charleston, Chesterfield, Clemson, Columbia, Conway, Darlington, Edgefield, Georgetown, Greenville, Manning, Marion, Newberry, Sumter, Union, Walterboro and York. Each location will have a Program Coordinator(s) handling the program for their site. The speakers for each session will present their material to the group in Clemson. Their presentations will be delivered to each site via satellite. There will be a toll-free number participants can use to ask questions of the presenters. Questions will also be answered at the local level.

## Dates

Workshop sessions will be held each Tuesday from February 1 through March 15, 2005. Sessions begin at 7:00 pm and last until 10:00 pm. Instructors and coordinators will be available through a toll-free number and on site until 10:00 pm. A field trip is planned around the end of the course. Several local sites may host a joint field trip. Check with your site coordinator.

Your site coordinator will send a card confirming your registration and giving you information on the location for your area. You should receive this card about 5 days before the first session. You can contact your area coordinator using the information listed for your area.


